3. Praise to Christ who nailed up - on that tree loosed our sin - ful bond at Cal - va - ry,




Now we thank the One who gives us bread, wipes out sins and gives us love, in - stead.

mak-ing all of us a - live and free, fel - low-ship-ping for e - ter-ni - ty!




God is bet - ter than the best of friends, who, when we have a need, in love at - tends.
